Topic: Importance of Pre-Trip Inspections



Policy

The Traxx Group of Companies is committed to protecting its employees from health and safety risks associated with an unsafe workplace. In our Inspection Policy, Transportation Policy and Preventative Maintenance policy states the importance of conducting inspections on vehicles prior to use. The vehicle inspection is to be completed by all Owners, Management, Supervisors and Employees.

Why?

By conducting an inspection prior to use identifies any hazards like broken parts, leaks, and low tire pressure etc. Neglecting vehicle inspections raises the chance of accidents due to undetected mechanical issues. Delayed maintenance can result in brake failures or tire blowouts, leading to dangerous situations. Regular inspections directly contribute to accident prevention by identifying potential safety hazards early.

National Safety Code

Commercial vehicles are required by the National Safety Code (NSC) to complete a daily pre-trip.

Procedures

Daily Pre-trips can be completed on Samsara and in Fastfield. If you are required to do daily logs your daily pre-trips should be completed in Samsara. Pickups PT-14, PT-10, PT-9, and PT-8 are completed on Fastfield.

Monthly Pre-Trip Inspections are on Fastfield for all Pickups, Service Trucks and High-rail Trucks.
